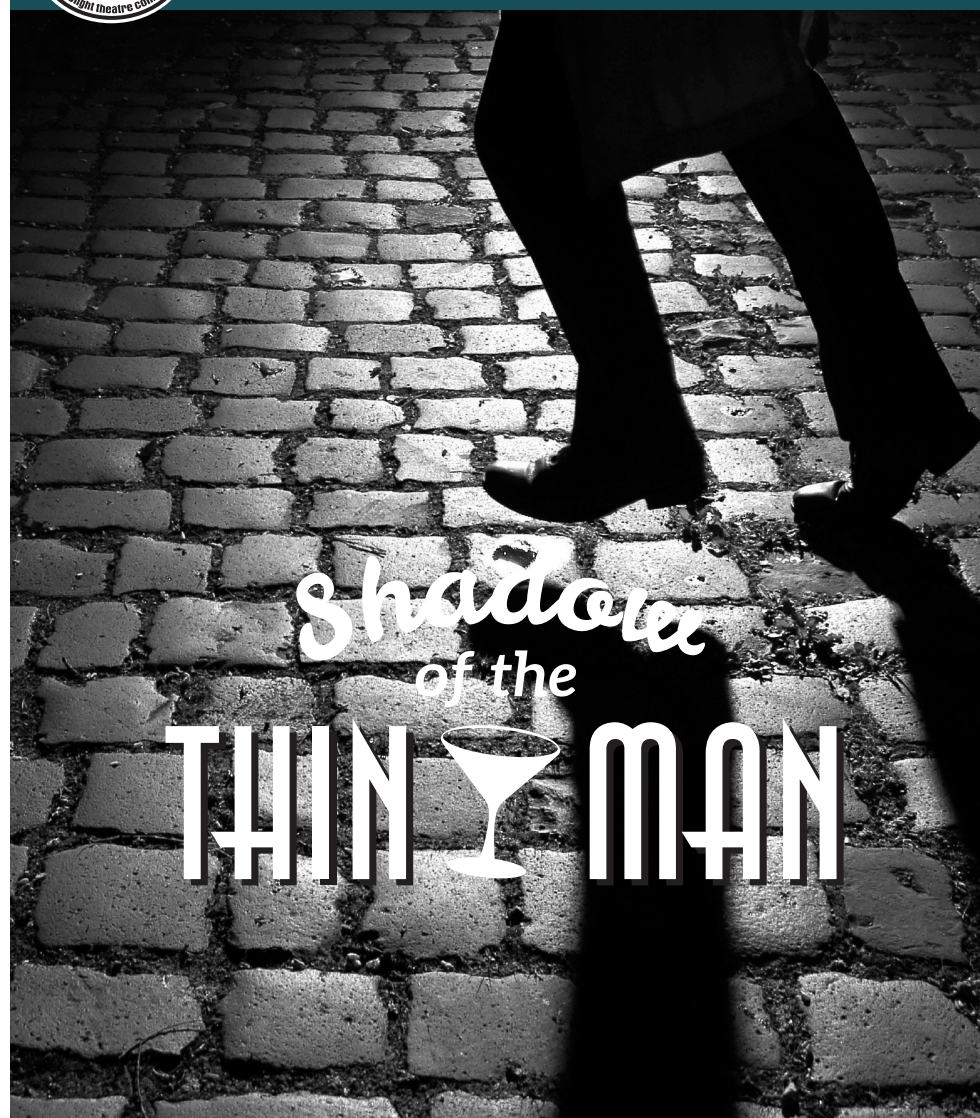
A panel of judges will critique submitted outfits and award a cash prize to the top look.

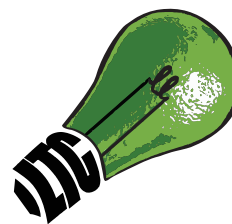
## DIRECTOR'S NOTE
