There are few things quite as recognizable as the Addams Family theme song - the iconic snaps have popped up in our culture many times in the decades since the original television show began airing in 1964, and the Addams Family has existed since even earlier, originating from a 1938 comic in The New Yorker. The story of this delightfully dark and twisted family has entertained audiences over the years as they find themselves in plenty of kooky situations, but the most interesting part to see is the Addams family dynamic. They are a family with as much love for each other as they have for the macabre, and in every iteration over the years, including this one, that remains true.

Throughout this process, we've had so much fun exploring that chaotic, sometimes dysfunctional family dynamic as the Addams navigate a number of suspiciously normal challenges; Dishonesty, fear of change, meeting your partner's parents for the first time, wooing the moon - okay, maybe not that last one. As we look through the gothic lens of the Addams, we can see how much we have in common with this gloomy family, and in the same hour, we see them overcome their troubles with an outpouring of love and support. A pretty perfect ending, if you ask any of the ancestors. And we hope that once the curtain has closed and you're leaving with the wisdom of the Addams Family, perhaps take with you Lurch's advice: Move towards the darkness – and smile.


