FAQ:

Is there a fee to Audition?

There is no audition fee, but there is a registration fee per production. Registration is due after the cast list has been announced, prior to the first rehearsal.

Can an actor be in more than one production?

YES! If you are interested in performing in more than one show that you are eligible for, you are welcome to audition for and participate in multiple shows! You will need to prepare audition materials for each show that you want to audition for, but you only need to sign up for one audition time.

What if an actor's birthday is over the summer and that impacts which performance they can be in?

If an actor turns the lower age for a production by September 1, 2024, they are able to audition for that production. If they are the upper age at the start of the summer, they are able to be in that production and do not "age out" because they turn 15 during the run of the show.

Step One: Sign Up for an Audition Time



- Go to limelighttheatrecompany.org to sign up for an audition time May 15-17 from 5:30-8:30pm or May 18 from 10:00am-4:00pm.
- Each audition takes 5-10 minutes.
- Download and fill out Casting Sheet, sign waiver on Casting Sheet, attach conflicts, and a photo.
- Prepare a monologue and song (if applicable) from the Audition Packet for each show you are interested in.



Step Two: Auditions and Callbacks

- Auditions for ALL SHOWS will be held at the the Oswegoland Park District's South Point facility (810 Preston Lane, Oswego; adjacent to Southbury Elementary) May 15-May 17 at Boulder Point (Zero Boulder Hill Pass) May 18.
- On the day of your audition, please bring your completed Casting Sheet and give it to the directors before you perform your monologue and/or song.
- Callback lists will be posted on our website by 8:00pm on Saturday, May 18.
- If you are on the callback list, you will be asked to return for a callback session on Sunday, May 19 at the Oswegoland Park District's South Point facility (810 Preston Lane, Oswego; adjacent to Southbury Elementary). Please plan on staying the entire time.
- If you are not on the callback list, this does not necessarily mean you did not receive a role in the show. It simply means that we did not need to see you perform again to know where you fit best. We hope to cast as many people as possible in our productions this summer, but we cannot guarantee that everyone will receive a part, or be cast in every show of their choice.
- Cast lists will be posted on the Limelight website by Wednesday, May 22.

Step Three: Register for your Show

Once you have been cast in a production, you need to register with the Oswegoland Park District. You can do this:

- Online
- Over the phone by calling 630.554.1010 (with Annual Waiver on file)
- In person by going into one of the park district buildings.
- Visit oswegolandparkdistrict.org for online registration and building addresses and operating hours.

All registration fees are to be paid by the first day of rehearsal for your production. Participants will not be allowed to attend rehearsals or receive a script until fees are paid. A \$10 late fee will be added to any late registrations.



Registration fees* and due dates:

- \$179 for Cover Me (#27840) due by May 20
- \$189 for Community Day (#27844) due by May 28
- \$239 for Disney's Descendants: The Musical (#27845) due by May 28
- \$299 for The SpongeBob Musical (#27847) due by June 17
